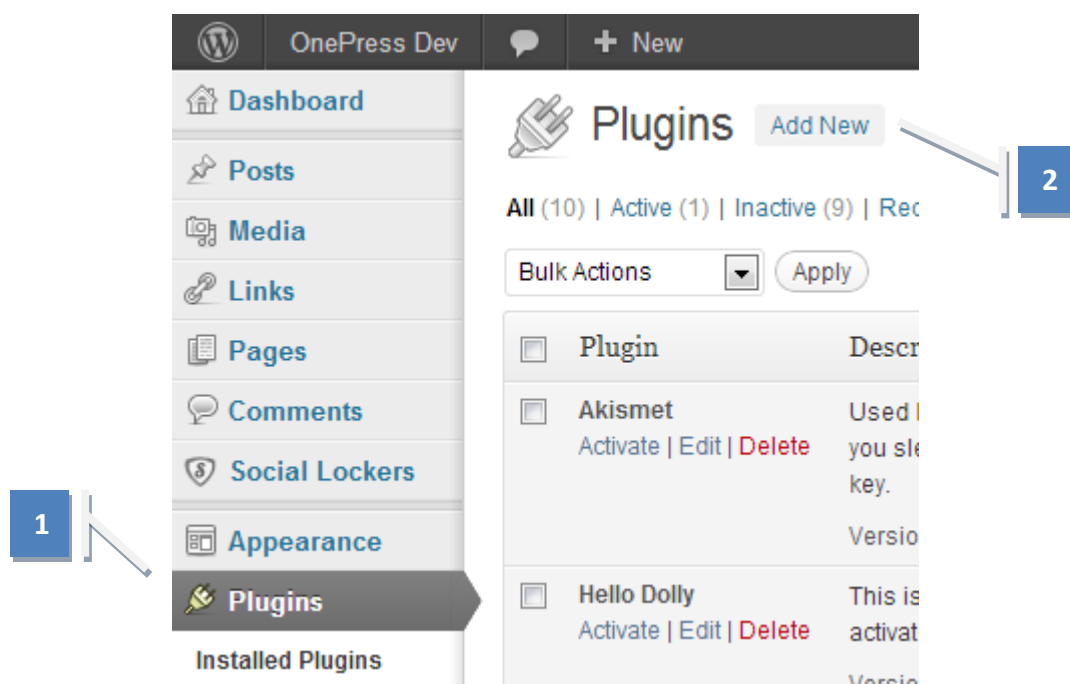
## [Installation]

The plugin installation is easy. To install the plugin you should just upload it on your server, activate it and submit your license key.

### Step #1. Install on Wordpress

---

1. Select the menu «**Plugins**».
2. Click on the button «**Add New**».



3. Click on the link «**Upload**».
4. Upload the file « **plugin-clipboard-images-1.8.8-premium.zip** » from the download archive and click on the button «**Install Now**».



5. Wait until the installation is complete and click the link «**Activate Plugin**».

## Step #2. Register your plugin instance

After the activation, you should register your instance of plugin and enter a valid license key. Click “Social Locker” in the admin menu to open License Manager.

## [Usage]

In order to use the plugin put some image into the clipboard, then open the post editor (Visual or HTML mode) and paste image. After a while, the image will appear inside the post content. Images are stored in Media Library as if you would use the standard way to insert image.

Use the button above the editor to enable and disable the plugin:



## Important notes

---

- The drag & drop feature works in all the major browsers: Chrome, Firefox, Safari, IE10, Opera.
- The copy & paste feature currently works in Chrome and the latest versions of Firefox, we expect that it will be available for other browsers soon. The plugin supports pasting only images from clipboard, not local files from hard disk even they are images.
